Addendum to the Johns Hopkins University Policy on Classified and Other
Restricted Research**

The Whiting School of Engineering (WSE) is committed to maintaining an environment that values and protects the free and open exchange of ideas and research results. WSE also shares the University's commitment to public service and supports faculty participation in research that contributes to the national security and may involve classified information. Hence, WSE fully supports and complies with the University's policy on classified and other restricted research.

In addition to the requirements outlined in the University's policy, WSE policy limits the amount of time that tenured and tenure-track faculty may participate in research that is not open, i.e. classified or proprietary research. Therefore, tenured and tenure-track faculty are limited to one day per week (or 52 days a year) working on consulting or classified research (combined). This limit applies whether or not the faculty member is being paid through University funds.
