

J-CHECK TEST INSTRUCTIONS

What is iTEP?

[iTEP](#) is an online and on-demand English language evaluation for colleges and universities. It is graded in 24 hours and backed by a team of ESL professionals.

What is J-Check?

J-Check is the company that administers the iTEP test. J-Check specializes in English proficiency testing for J-1 scholars but is allowing international students from China to use their services under special circumstances. The actual test students will take is the iTEP Academic but it is referred to as the “J-Check test” when it is taken using the method below.

Instructions:

1. JHU school provides student with a link to JHU site on the J-Check website:

The JHU site is not restricted so students can also find it by going to the main J-Check website <https://www.jchecktest.com/> and selecting “Find My School”.

2. Student accesses J-Check and purchases a J-Check test ID and password.

The J-Check website will route the student to Paypal where they pay for the test ID and password. The fee is 99 USD. Within 48 hours, the student will receive their test ID and password.

3. Student takes the J-Check test.

Students will have the opportunity to take a free practice test first. Then they will proceed to the official J-Check test.

The test must be taken on a PC desktop or laptop computer with internet access, a microphone and an activated webcam. It cannot be taken on a MAC computer or on a tablet or smartphone. Technical requirements are provided on the J-Check website:

4. Test results are emailed to JHU within 24 hours.

Once the student completes the test, results are sent via email to Dacia Gauer in the Office of International Services. She will forward the results to the school’s admissions office. Students will also receive a copy of their test results via email.
