



Department of Materials Science and Engineering Master's Research Scholarship

The Department of Materials Science and Engineering will award the Materials Research Scholarship in the form of 80% tuition remission to eligible Master of Science in Engineering (MSE) students. Students are responsible for the remaining 20% of full tuition. The scholarship will be awarded for one semester, and extensions may be permitted in certain cases. Students retain the health insurance benefit extended by the Whiting School of Engineering; students on the CHP plan will be required to pay the first \$500 (\$250 per semester) towards the mandatory health insurance fee. The remainder of the fee will be covered by the Whiting School of Engineering.

A student is eligible for this scholarship if

1. The student's primary degree program is the terminal MSE degree in Materials Science and Engineering at Johns Hopkins.
2. The student is working full-time towards completion of the MSE degree in Materials Science and Engineering.
3. The student has completed all the coursework, other than research, required for an MSE degree in Materials Science and Engineering and is in good academic standing.
4. The student is not enrolled in any courses other than Graduate Research (EN.510.807 or EN.510.808) throughout the semesters in which the MSE research scholarship is applied.
5. The student has maintained full-time resident status as a graduate student at JHU for at least two semesters. Note that KSAS/WSE alumni *may* count undergraduate semesters towards this requirement in certain cases. Please check with the director of the MSE program for details.
6. The student is not receiving the Dean's Master's Fellowship in the semester that the Materials Research Scholarship is applied. Students who have received the Dean's Master's Fellowship in previous semesters are still eligible.
7. The student has the support of his/her research advisor and the department.
